**REPORT OF THE SECRETARY-GENERAL CONCERNING
THE SITUATION IN ABKHAZIA, GEORGIA**Addendum

1. In my report to the Security Council of 27 October 1993 (S/26646), I indicated in paragraph 11 that I would submit an addendum to the report stating the financial implications of the operation as described in paragraph 10 of the report.
2. Should the Security Council approve my recommendation for the continuation of the United Nations Observer Mission in Georgia (UNOMIG) at its present strength of Chief Military Observer, four military observers and six international staff for a further three months, it is estimated that the total cost would amount to \$612,000 gross for the period. The monthly cost thereafter would amount to \$204,000 gross. A breakdown of the estimated cost by main categories of expenditure is provided for information purposes in the annex to the present addendum.
3. It would be my recommendation to the General Assembly, should the Security Council decide to approve my recommendation, that the costs relating thereto should be considered an expense of the Organization to be borne by Member States in accordance with Article 17, paragraph 2, of the Charter of the United Nations and that the assessments to be levied on Member States should be credited to the UNOMIG special account to be established for that purpose.
